CONFIRMATION DRESS CODE

We ask that our Confirmation candidates please dress appropriately for the sacrament of Confirmation. Following is the dress code for reception of the sacrament of Confirmation. We also ask that the sponsors consider dressing modestly and for the occasion of Confirmation as the students are asked to. This is not meant to be strict but to remember that we are at a joyous celebration, like a wedding and we are asking you to dress for the occasion. We ask that the sponsors dress accordingly as well.

Men

Men are asked to wear dress pants, dress shoes (please no sneakers or flip flops), a tie and a belt. Ties must be either solid or have simple standard patterns. Please no ties with logos or characters. Khaki pants are acceptable.

Men please wear a collared shirt. Please nothing overly bright or gaudy. Shirts must be solid or pinstripe. Sport coats are acceptable but not required. Suits are acceptable but not required.

Please do not wear jeans, sandals, flip flops, or sneakers/trainers/tennis shoes.

Women

Ladies are asked to wear a modest dress (or an appropriate skirt and dress top) and dress shoes. Dresses/skirts must fully cover the knees. Dresses may not be backless or low cut. If a dress is strapless or the straps do not cover the shoulders, then a jacket or sweater is required and must be worn for the duration of the liturgy.

Please do not wear flip flops or sneakers/trainers/tennis shoes.

Makeup is acceptable but not required. Please do not apply an excessive amount of makeup.

There is no specific color necessary, however please no overly bright colors that would be distracting during the liturgy, in example a neon yellow/orange colored outfit may be distracting.
